
Prayer Garden

Sneedville, TN

Much work was done to prepare the historic prayer garden, located at Berean Echad Springs Fellowship in Sneedville, for the Feast of Shavuot. We have been told by the previous owners of the property that this area was used many years ago by pioneers as a place to gather for prayer and fellowship. A large decaying wooden cross, podium, and decaying wooden benches where there when we first moved to the property. There is a sense of peace found in this area.

Due to time and a lack of upkeep, this meeting area had become overrun by wild mountain vegetation and fallen trees. In an effort to restore the area and make it an inviting area to gather, grading was done to remove fallen trees, large rocks and to flatten the land. The area was then further cleared by hand and fast growing rye grass was scattered. A timely thunderstorm came the same night the seed was scattered and gave the entire area a great watering. Within a few days, the entire area was covered in soft grass.

The whole area was looking beautiful as the afternoon sun rays shone through the trees. The Friday leading up to Shavuot, despite the weather forecast not looking great for the feast day, we went and cleared some areas around a few trees, planted flowers and other plants and made decorative borders with rocks. Bug repellent citronella torches where put into the ground.

PRAYER GARDEN

(cont.) Despite many prayers to hold off the rain for Shavuot and bring sunshine, it ended up raining for the feast day. The garden received nourishment from the water, but it was slightly disappointing that we were not able to celebrate there. This garden will be used for future feast days and potentially Hebraic weddings.



Natural benches made by a man in Rutledge from re-purposed telephone poles were purchased and arranged in the garden.




Perennial flowers were planted around some of the trees and rocks placed as decorative borders.

Please write out a one page "testimony" of how you have seen Yah have a hand in your personal development regarding skills, abilities, talents, and gifts. We will share these first. It can be bullet points but something written so that everyone can have some thinking time in advance.

Please go to https://store.gallup.com/p/en-us/10108/top-5-cliftonstrengths to purchase (\$20) a StrengthsFinder test. They may have a group rate if you call them for those that would like to purchase together. You can also get the full report (\$60) but the top 5 is often the most informative. This is the only paid test.

- 8) Part 5: Conclusion and Last Comments
